- Applicants not chosen for the awards will be notified via email by March 31st 2010
- Upon receipt of the signed scholarship agreement, monies shall be distributed to the applicant directly via cash or personal check. (QYS award ceremony location, time and date TBA)

CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

Awards will be made on the basis of the involvement in the before mentioned music, art and community categories within their personal and creative essays. In order to include all students, please do not send transcripts or GPA information. Submissions and all included materials will not be returned. Decisions of the Scholarship committee are final. PART 1: PERSONAL ESSAY

The purpose of the PERSONAL ESSAY is to give the applicant an opportunity to share important information on their life, events that might have shaped them, influences, extra curricular activities and most importantly their future goals. Essays should be no more than 500 words (12pt font). All submissions become the property of Cut&Paste Rock&Roll. Personal essays should include, but not be limited to, the following information:

1. A brief description of yourself
2. Description of any music, art or community service involvement.
4. Explanation of involvement, if any, specifically within the LGBTQQIA community.
5. Explanation of how awarding you this scholarship will benefit the Queer community.
6. Any other pertinent information about the applicant, the applicant's story and goals.

PART 2: CREATIVE ESSAY

The purpose of the CREATIVE ESSAY is to allow the applicant to express themselves through art (in approved mediums). The applicant reserves the rights to the art sent in to CPRR and allows CPRR the rights to use the art submitted in all publicity.

The following mediums will be accepted:

- Music (if not original music, credit must be given to composer/artist)
 - o Must include written/typed lyrics
 - o No less than 1 minute or more than 10 minutes in length
 - o Send recorded audio on CD or DVD format to the address listed
 - Send email MP3 or link to audio along with your application to info@cutandpasterockandroll.com.
- Poetry (written or performed must include written/typed version of the work)
- Performance (must include website link or DVD of performance)
- Painting (if not shippable, applicant must include high resolution photo of work)
- Drawing (if not shippable, applicant must include high resolution photo of work)
- Digital (if not shippable, applicant must include high resolution photo of work)
- Design (if not shippable, applicant must include high resolution photo of work)
- Photography (if not shippable, applicant must include high resolution photo of work)
